First Communion Enrolment Mass

This Monday 18th Oct at 7.30pm, children from Loreto, Harold, Castle Park and St. Patrick's Schools will gather with their parents in the church for their enrolment ceremony and first gathering for Mass in the "Do this in Memory" programme. This parish based programme is intended to complement the sharing of faith and preparation for the Sacraments which take place both at home and in the school. Everyone is welcome to the Mass to support the parents and children as they begin their preparation for First Communion.

November List of the Dead envelopes

Parishioners are invited to list their loved ones who have died by taking the appropriate envelopes with enclosed forms, available in the church porches. Names will be placed on the altar throughout November and on First Fridays during the year. We mark All Souls Day on Monday week.

Mission Sunday next weekend - 24th Oct

Mission Sunday takes place this year on next Sunday, 24th October. This annual collection, which takes place in Catholic churches worldwide, provides financial assistance to young churches and missionaries, allowing them to meet the spiritual and human needs of some of the world's poorest people.
